

Student Learning Models for 2020-21

The chart below describes the student learning models available this fall.

Option 1: In-School Instruction	Option 2: At Home Virtual Instruction Virtual Academy different from eLearning in the Spring.
 Students will attend their assigned school daily, (teacher-led instruction). Daily attendance will be taken. Enhanced health and safety protocols (increased cleaning, mask usage, frequent handwashing, hand sanitizer stations and social distancing). Reduced class transitions and large group interaction to ensure social distancing. Related arts, intervention, and special education teachers who support students within the family would rotate. Students receiving pull out services will be routed out of the classroom using enhanced safety protocols to include masks as well as social distancing. 	 Students will remain registered at their assigned school, but will remain at home and attend classes online daily (teacher-led instruction). Daily attendance will be taken. Support services available (ex. IEP meetings, ESL support, social emotional support, etc) Virtual parent meetings are required. Parent Progress Meetings (onsite) are required. Students will be required to test onsite (depending on grade level). Limited availability of extracurricular programs and activities that require on-campus participation (athletics not included-students will still be able to participate). Families are required to commit to FSD3 Virtual Academy for at least 1 semester (90 days).

Florence 3's Virtual Program will provide students with the same learning opportunities as face to face instruction, but with a different delivery method.

In our Virtual Program students will work oneon-one with their teacher and in small groups with peers.

The schedule is designed to mirror the high expectations we have for our face to face program and will require a daily commitment from students and parents.

EXPECTATIONS

- → Students enrolled in Virtual Programs will need access to a device and regular access to reliable WiFi.
- → The District will be able to provide devices to all participating students and WiFi hotspots to most families in need (completed application for hotspots are required).

Schedule:

 The schedule will closely mirror a traditional school day and will require students to engage in daily live instruction with whole group, small group, and individual options.

Attendance:

 Daily attendance is required and will be taken throughout the day.




- Log in to your chromebook with your school gmail.

- Click on the Google Classroom icon





2. HOW TO LOCATE AND SUBMIT WORK




3. GOOGLE MEETS (WHOLE GROUP/SMALL GROUP)

Teachers will provide students with a link to the meetings.



1 Students should have their microphone turned off and their camera turned on before they join the meet.



2 Once you are ready click "Join Now" to join the meeting.

3. GOOGLE MEETS (WHOLE GROUP/SMALL GROUP)



Once you are in the meet, your teacher will go over the norms and expectations for how to use the chat feature, how and when to unmute to ask questions, and other items as needed.



3. GOOGLE MEETS (WHOLE GROUP/SMALL GROUP)



- Students can see the teacher in the meet as well as other students and the teacher can see the students.
- Teachers can present their screen to help teach their lessons.
- Teachers may ask students to unmute to respond to or ask questions, they may also ask students to type responses in the chat.
- Students should follow the same behavior expectations and rules in the meet like the would in the classroom.

4. USING GOOGLE DOCS AND SLIDES



Google Docs is a word processor where students can create, share, and edit documents online

Google Slides is a presentation program where students can create, share and edit, presentations online.





Google drive is a file storage system online where students files will be stored.

4. USING GOOGLE DOCS AND SLIDES







Students will primarily use docs and slides to complete their assignments.

Teachers will provide students with specific skills like changing fonts, adding pictures and graphics, formatting, etc. as needed for different assignments.

Because docs, slides, and drive are web based, students work is saved automatically while they are working.

6. CREATING AN "AT HOME" LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

- Students are required to be in a setting that allows for learning, free from distractions as much as possible, and be dressed and ready for school.
- Set up a desk area that is designated for Virtual Learning.









What is my role as the parent/guardian?

- Set up a space in the home with learning supplies and materials
- Provide expectations of a schedule and structure for online learning
- Assist your child with accessing online instruction
- Monitor your child to ensure he/she is participating in online learning
- Encourage your child to be engaged in online learning
- Understand that online learning is different from in-school learning and flexibility will be needed
- Reach out to your child's teacher for assistance when needed

What is the student's role?

- ★ Stick to a daily routine and learning schedule
- * Work in a designated learning space away from distractions
- * Be an active learner
- ★ Let your teacher know if you need help
- * Follow 'Netiquette' when you are working online
- * Stay focused on the topic being discussed
- ★ Use respectful behavior and language
- ★ Wear school appropriate clothing if on video conferencing
- ★ Be honest and do not copy others' work as your own
- * Show consideration for others

What are the Attendance and Engagement Expectations?




ATTENDANCE: Students are expected to be active participants daily in their independent and online learning experience. Teachers will track virtual attendance in multiple ways.
