December 31 Deadline Approaching to Incur Eligible MSA Expenses for 2019

Remember that Medical Spending Account (MSA) participants must incur eligible expenses by December 31, 2019, and submit valid claims for those expenses before March 31, 2020.

Participants who don't use all their funds can carry over up to \$500 in unused funds into 2020. Participants will forfeit any unused funds over \$500. MSA participants can log in to their account at www.ASIFlex.com/SCMoneyPlus to check their account balance.

Participants can use their ASIFlex Card or pay out of pocket for expenses and submit a claim for reimbursement. There are several ways to submit a claim:

- ASIFlex mobile app: Just snap a picture of the itemized statement of service(s) or insurance explanation of benefits (EOB) and submit a claim via the app.
- ASIFlex Online: Sign in online to submit a claim.
- Toll-free fax or mail: Download and complete a claim form. Then, submit it with an itemized statement of service(s) or EOB.
